Call 999 if someone is in immediate danger. Call 101 to contact local police for non emergencies.



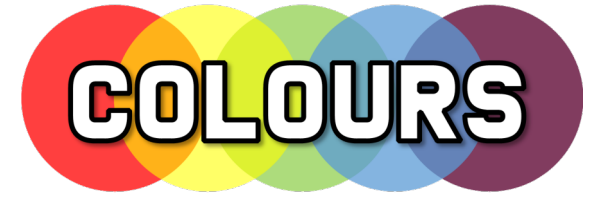

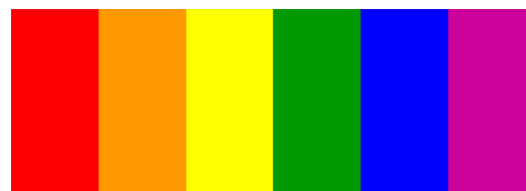

Colours' History

The idea for Colours was originally formed in 2018, when teachers union member Keren Townsend approached one of the directors of Weston's Proud Bar to establish if the venue would be available out of trading hours for a group of like-minded 13 - 17-year olds to meet on a monthly basis. Its purpose was to encourage peer support for individuals who would otherwise be isolated and to build something new for the LGBT+ youth of Weston. With Keren available for support, the group formed and appeared at Weston-super-Mare Pride 2019 with the support of director Nigel Briars.

During the coronavirus pandemic of 2020 the decision was made for the **North Somerset LGBT+ Forum** to adopt Colours from Proud to support online mental health support within the community.. Under the wing of the Forum, Colours aims to continue to provide a safe space for the young LGBT community of Weston.
